Adopting online mode helped us to reach reach hundreds of the students under this beyond books project.

The year was remarking for the new initiatives viz. Gender awareness and Mental Health Helpline. Gender awareness online sessions started in collaboration with IQAC Cluster. We are planning to develop a short term certificate course which will be useful for college students. Mental health helpline project is also taking a shape. Our team members are dedicatedly spreading the word about mental health importance.

Since this year MCF widened the scope of sessions for the doctors. We organized online lecture series on De-addiction, Emergency medicines, Diabetes, Pharmacology, and Medical Practice Management. We are happy that the response was overwhelming. Staring of year 2022 was a time to go offline due to relaxed restrictions after covid-19. Hence we organized an offline De-addiction certificate course at B.J Medical College in collaboration with Rotary Club of Pune Katraj. It was a great feeling to meet everyone and having super response to the program.

In spite of challenges, problems, and worries all around, our volunteers worked passionately with hope in their eyes. We did a small gesture of thanks giving by arranging a small meeting in person. The team is growing and so do MCF. We extend our gratitude to all the well-wishers, supporters and donors for being with us and boosting our confidence.

# WHO WE ARE? WHAT WE DO?

Muktaa charitable foundation (MCF) is a Pune based Non-Government organization. In 2005 a group of socially like-minded dedicated volunteers came together and worked in the field of health at different levels. This group led the path for awareness about HIV & AIDS by educating doctors through series of lectures. Realizing the need for creating awareness about this disease amongst public, in 2005 they launched Samvad HIV Helpline with trained counsellors, answering calls from callers about HIV, dispelling their doubts and creating awareness about the disease. In 2010, MCF was registered with Charity Commissioner Pune. Since then MCF has undertaken many ed projects to fulfil the need about health and health awareness.

## MISSION:

- 1. To contain the epidemic of HIV, Tuberculosis, Oral Cancer and Addictions in society. Educating doctors, and public along with creating awareness about these diseases.
- 2. To make systematic disclosure to HIV positive children to ensure better life for them.
- 3. To create awareness and educate doctors, students and general public on Oral Cancer, HIV, TB, Other STD's, Hepatitis B & C, Addiction etc.
- 4. To educate children/ adolescents about life skills development.


# Samvad HIV Helpline




The current team of counsellors is very efficient at knowledge of the domain and at the skills of counselling.



# First Aid For All

Emergencies can never be thought of and hence being attentive and ready helps to save the lives. MCF's journey for first aid started due to collaboration with Pratham education foundation, where MCF is an expert organization in this field.

#### Work nature:

Expert calls: In the year 21-22 we have reached to around 16000 youth though the expert call or doubt clearing sessions organized by Pratham. These calls are conducted in various Indian Languages, and MCF is growing with the team of Doctors from various states.

Content related inputs: MCF is involved in reviewing the content for First Aid developed by Pratham

In the offline mode MCF also organized CPR training for athletes group on 16th March 2022 where Dr. Rajkumar Shah from Red Cross Society, Pune introduced participants to CPR and also the types of bandages. At the end of the session participants also tried to do CPR on mannequin.




